

Agreement
between the University of Salzburg
and St. Petersburg State University

1. Objective

The general purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the exchange of students of both universities.

2. Agreement

2.1. At the University of Salzburg, a coordinator will have administrative responsibility for the program. At St. Petersburg State University there will also be a coordinator responsible for the administration of the exchange.

2.2. Both universities will exchange up to three students per semester.

2.3. The exchange students will remain registered at their home institution and pay regular tuition fees to their home university. No other fees will be payable.

2.4. Exchange students will normally stay at the host institution for one or two semesters. Within the limits of applicable laws, students have the right to take exams at the host institution and to receive transcripts. Academic work will be transferable to the home institution. For students from the University of Salzburg such work will be transferred, if the exams taken at the host institution correspond to their degree program in Salzburg.

2.5. Visiting students will have the same rights and privileges to use the university library and other university units as other regular students at the host institution.

2.6. Both universities will suggest suitable accommodation for the visiting students.

2.7. Any insurance costs are the responsibility of the participants in the exchange.

2.8. Both universities will make efforts to seek funding to support the exchange.

2.9. This agreement covers also other activities, if they are mutually agreed upon by both institutions.


3. Validity

3.1. This agreement is originally valid for a period of three years and may be renewed for further periods of three years by mutual agreement. It may be terminated by either side at one year's notice. Both universities agree to establish a balance in the number of exchanged students, even after termination of the agreement.

3.2. The program will start the day after this agreement will be signed by the appropriate representatives of both universities.



**Agreement for a Program of Academic Linkage and Cooperation
between the University of Salzburg and St. Petersburg State University**

1. The general purpose of this agreement is to facilitate academic cooperation between the University of Salzburg and St. Petersburg State University.
2. At the University of Salzburg, a coordinator in cooperation with the Office of Foreign Relations will have administrative responsibility for the general administration of the exchange. At St. Petersburg State University a designated coordinator will have administrative responsibility for the general administration of the exchange.
3. The specific aim of this agreement is to institute and conduct an academic exchange of both undergraduate and graduate students as well as faculty members. Each institution will exchange up to three students per academic year. Applications for faculty exchange will be processed by the coordinators of each institution.
4. Faculty members and students from St. Petersburg State University and the University of Salzburg will visit the other institution in order to participate in joint research projects and educational programs.
5. Participating students will pay the required tuition fees to their home institution; any other minor fees will be payable at the host institution.
6. St. Petersburg State University and the University of Salzburg will assist in finding suitable accommodation for the faculty members and students. All travel, housing, and living costs are the responsibility of the visitor.
7. Adequate health insurance is required for all participants.
8. Both universities will make efforts to seek funding to support the exchange.
9. The agreement is originally valid for a period of three years. It may be automatically renewed for additional three-years periods unless either party provides the other with a notice of termination no later than sixty days prior to the expiration of the preceding period.
