

FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION

between

THE PARIS-LODRON UNIVERSITY OF SALZBURG, AUSTRIA

and

THE SAINT-PETERSBURG UNIVERSITY, RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Professional Education "Saint-Petersburg State University" (hereinafter referred to as "SPbU"), in the person of its Senior Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs and Research Professor Igor Gorlinsky, acting on the basis of proxy dated 08.11.2010 №12-21-3,

and **the Paris-Lodron University of Salzburg**, in the person of its Vice-Rector for International Relations Professor Sonja Puntsher-Riekmann,

hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties" and each solely to as "the Party",

aiming to continue successful cooperation between the Parties,

enter into this Framework Agreement for Cooperation (hereinafter - the Agreement) and agree upon following:

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1.1. The Parties will continue academic, scientific, cultural and other kinds of cooperation in the areas of mutual interest of the Parties, including involvement of third parties such as educational, research and scientific institutions, organizations and associations.
- 1.2. The Parties will continue cooperation in various forms including but not limited to:
 - Exchange of students,
 - Exchange of faculty, academic and administrative staff;
 - Planning, organizing and implementation of joint research, scientific, educational and cultural programs and events;
 - Development and implementation of joint double degree programmes;
 - Exchange of information and experience;
 - Other collaborative activities of mutual interest of the Parties, including publishing activities, exchange of bibliographic materials and shared access to information networks.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2.1 Detailed rules, responsibilities, specific mechanisms and financial conditions of each particular cooperative project and collaborative activity mentioned in §1 of above are subject for additional protocols, working programmes, specific agreements and appendixes to the present Agreement, which shall be duly signed by the Parties and become an integral part of this Agreement.



3. DURATION AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- 3.1 This Agreement shall become effective on the date that it is signed by the Parties and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years, and may be renewed by mutual written consent.
- 3.2 At the end of the five-year period, the duration of this Agreement may be prolonged by mutual written agreement of the Parties for an additional five (5) year period.
- 3.3 Any changes or amendments to this Agreement are subject to the written consent of both Parties.
- 3.4 This Agreement may be terminated by either Party at any time provided that the terminating Party gives written notice of its intention at least six (6) months prior to termination.

4. FINAL PROVISIONS

- 4.1 Should any dispute or disagreement arise between the Parties connected with or concerning this Agreement, the Parties shall first try to resolve the dispute by negotiations. If the dispute has not been resolved by such negotiations within 30 days since the dispute arose, the Parties shall be free to submit the dispute to a court of the respondent's place of business. The applicable law is law of the country where the questionable commitment arose.
- 4.2 Both Parties shall not use names and logos of the other Party without its prior consent, if it is not directly related to the performance of obligations under this Agreement.
- 4.3 This Agreement is made in two original and equal copies in English language, one copy for each Party.


