Registration and Visa Extension



REGISTRATION PROCEDURE UPON ARRIVAL

Important: during your entire stay in Russia you must be registered.

To get the registration:

- If you live in a **dormitory**: visit your coordinator's office for registration within <u>3 working days</u> after your arrival.
- If you live in a rented apartment: your owner has to register you.

Important: the University cannot register you at a private address, so contact your owner & discuss registration details in advance.



REGISTRATION RULES: travelling inside Russia

Important: re-register every time you stay in another city for more than 7 working days.

- If you live in a dormitory: visit your coordinator's office for registration within 3 working days after your arrival.
- If you live in a rented apartment: your owner has to re-register you
- Good news: if you stay at your friends' house or rent an apartment in another city - NO NEED to re-register.



REGISTRATION RULES: travelling outside Russia

Important: you must repeat registration process every time you cross the Russian border.

- If you live in a **dormitory**: bring your hotel / hostel registration to your coordinator within 3 working days upon arrival.
- If you live in a rented apartment: your owner has to re-register you again.









- your first visa is valid for 90 days & allows you only one entry to Russia
- the procedure starts ~1 month before the visa expiration date.

Example: your visa expires on 30/11, so we apply the documents on 20/10.

- the procedure takes around 30-40 working days ⇒
- please, do not plan trips outside Russia before your visa is extended.



MANDATORY MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Important: after you <u>first</u> entry to Russia you have <u>90</u> <u>calendar days</u> to undergo the medical examination.

The procedure:

- Pass medical exams
- Submit fingerprints and biometric data to Federal Migration Service (FMS)
- Collect the confirming document at the FMS
- Send this document to your coordinator.





WHERE TO PASS?

Option 1:

- undergo both procedures at the FMS
- health examination: 5700 rubles
- biometric data collection: 300 rubles

Option 2:

- pass the medical checks at one of the accredited medical centers
- submit fingerprint in the FMS <u>after you receive the medical</u> results
- prices to be discussed at an accredited center
