Agreement of Academic Cooperation Between Kangnung National University, Republic of Korea and State University of Saint Petersburg, Russia

This Agreement is made and entered into this 17th day of November 2000, between Kangnung National University, Kangnung, Korea (hereafter called KNU), and St.Petersburg State University, St.Petersburg, Russia (hereafter called SPbSU).

This relationship will contribute to the friendship and the development of both institutions through exchange programs for faculty members, students, curricula and research programs, as well as administrative cooperation. KNU and SPbSU share a common commitment to quality education, high level academic research and the betterment of all people. The parties desire and intend to promote academic cooperation and to strengthen cultural ties between Korea and the Republic of Russia.

Now, therefore, it is agreed:

I. Exchange of Faculty Members

Both institutions shall encourage exchange of individual faculty members supported as much as possible by their respective resources and various international scholars programs or such individual granting agencies as are available.

II. Exchange of Students


Both institutions shall encourage exchange of their students. The detailed scope of the exchange, and financial contributions from both parties, will be determined by an Addendum to the present Agreement in the future.

III. Exchange of mutually agreed-upon publications and scholastic material

Both institutions encourage exchange of publications and materials that will be recommended by both parties.

IV. Collaboration on the research activities between the two Institutions

Both institutions encourage the collaborative researches in all areas of mutual interest. The number of joint researches and the sharing of the expenses will be mutually agreed upon by both institutions according to the requirement of each individual project.
