Agreement Between

Saint Petersburg State University School of International Studies And

The University of Miami Master of Arts in International Administration Program

Whereas, Saint Petersburg State University (SPSU) and The University of Miami (UM) wish to develop a program of cooperation in graduate studies for the mutual benefit of the two universities, and Whereas, SPSU has a well-developed School of International Relations (SIR), and Whereas, UM has a well-developed interdisciplinary Master of Arts in International Administration (professional graduate studies in international relations)

It is agreed that within the rules of our respective institutions:

- 1. Commencing in August 2004, a regular program of student exchanges between students of the SPSU School of International Relations and the UM Master of Arts in International Administration (MAIA) Program at numbers of students to be mutually negotiated.
- 2. SPSU- SIR and UM-MAIA will negotiate mutually satisfactory arrangements for intensive language training.
- SPSU-SIR will provide assistance to UM-MAIA in building internship programs for MAIA students in Russia.
- 4. SPSU-SIR and UM-MAIA will begin negotiations leading to a regular exchange of faculty and advanced graduate students for teaching and research.
- 5. SPSU-SIR and UM-MAIA will develop a joint program of research on the role of international nongovernmental organizations in the development of international civil society.
- 6. SPSU and UM will open discussions on the development of joint and dual degree programs in the area of international relations, broadly defined.
- 7. SPSU-SIR and UM-MAIA will cooperate to develop sources of funding to further this program of cooperation.

It is further agreed that the two universities will open discussions leading toward cooperation in other areas of graduate studies and faculty exchange.
