**Agreement for a BBA/iBBA Student
Exchange program
Between**

**SCHULICH
SCHOOL OF BUSINESS
YORK UNIVERSITY**

1. The signatories agree to an exchange of BBA/iBBA students from the Schulich School of Business, York University and BBA students from Graduate School of Management, St. Petersburg State University.
2. A maximum of 3 students will be exchanged in each direction each year. Students may attend the host school for one semester. The number of students exchanged in any one year need not be the same, but a reasonable balance should be sought over a three-year period.
3. After the first three years of this agreement, either host institution may decrease the number of students it accepts if such action will help to remedy a significant imbalance. At least six months notice must be given of any reduction in number. The number of students may be increased at any time by mutual agreement.
4. Candidates for exchange will be selected by their home institution. The host institution reserves the right to refuse the admission of candidates it considers to be unsuitable.
5. Students will remain members of their home institution. Tuition fees will be paid to the home institution and there will be no exchange of funds between institutions. Exchange students are exempt from paying tuition fees to the host institution during the exchange period, but are responsible for paying course material fees and other ancillary fees at the host institution.
6. Exchange students will be treated as regular students with the same opportunities to select courses. They will also be subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution during the period of exchange. At the end of the period, both institutions will supply the other with details of the academic performance of each student.

7. All living and travel expenses and insurance requirements remain the student's responsibility. Both institutions agree to assist students in their search for accommodation.
8. This agreement becomes effective from 1 May 2007 and continues indefinitely unless terminated in writing by either party. At least nine months notice shall be given by the party terminating the agreement.


