Article 1.

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to facilitate cooperation between St.Petersburg University (SPbU) and the European University Institute (EUI), in particular in the field of teaching opportunities by having advanced doctoral students and postdoctoral fellows of the EUI contribute to the taught program of International Relations and European Studies.

Article 2.

The teaching in the framework of this MOU will be done in English.

Article 3.

During the period they are teaching the doctoral student or postdoctoral fellow can keep their grant.

SPbU will contribute towards travel expenses and a supplement to cover additional expenditure for staying in St.Petersburg. This contribution can take the form of either a salary or a grant or some other form.

SPbU will provide assistance in finding accommodation for the advanced doctoral students and postdoctoral fellows of the EUI.

Each coming doctoral student and postdoctoral fellow of the EUI personally covers all expenses on insurance, visa and registration according to legislation of the Russian Federation.

Article 4.

Every year (no later than 1st of February) the EUI will provide a list of candidates, accompanied by a brief CV and statement concerning the disciplinary interests of the courses to offer. The period of their availability will also be listed.

Every year before 1st of February will formulate a list of courses for which it would like to receive teaching support from the EUI.

Article 5.

The final selection of the candidates for this teaching program will be carried out by the hosting institution.

Article 6.

Details of any of such visits will be subject to a separate Working program that will be attached to this MOU as an annexure.
