**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN

**The Faculty of Law, Business and Social Sciences, The University of Glasgow,  
Scotland, UK**  
and  
**The Faculty of Economics, St Petersburg State University, Russian Federation**

The university of Glasgow and St Petersburg State University, recognizing the benefits to their respective universities from the establishment of international links, conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

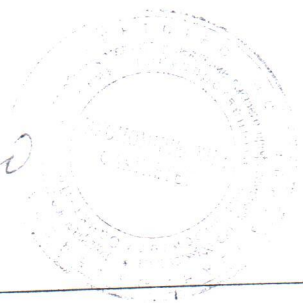
1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational co-operation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Universities.
2. Both Universities agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
  - 2.1) Exchange of faculty and administrative staff
  - 2.2) Exchange of students
  - 2.3) Conducting collaborative research projects
  - 2.4) Conducting lectures and organizing academic conferences
  - 2.5) Exchange of academic information and materials
  - 2.6) Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest
  - 2.7) Promoting other academic co-operation as mutually agreed
  - 2.8) Mutual recognition of courses in accordance with rules and regulations of respective universities which may count towards the award of a degree.
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the Faculty of Law, Business and Social Science, University of Glasgow and the Faculty of Economics, St Petersburg State University. Both universities agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.
4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the Universities concerned.
5. Should the collaborative research activities under this MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, both Universities shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
6. This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both universities.
7. This MoU is valid for a period of five years from the date of signing by the representatives of both Universities. This MoU shall be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both universities.
8. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Universities upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date.
