

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Date: December 25, 2015

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Saint-Petersburg State University» (hereinafter referred to as “Saint-Petersburg University”), duly represented by Deputy Rector for International Affairs Alexander Gogolevsky, acting on the basis of proxy dated 26.01.2015 № 28-21-64, from one side

And

Tallinn University, represented by Prof. Tiit Land, Rector, from the other side

acting on the basis of the bilateral Framework Agreement on Cooperation between two respected universities, duly signed on October 17, 2011,

herewith agree to prolong the Framework Agreement on Cooperation and the Program of Academic and Student Exchange for the educational track “Arts and Humanities” between two respected universities, duly signed on October 17, 2011, for the next 5 (five)-year period and hence to consider it as valid till 2021.

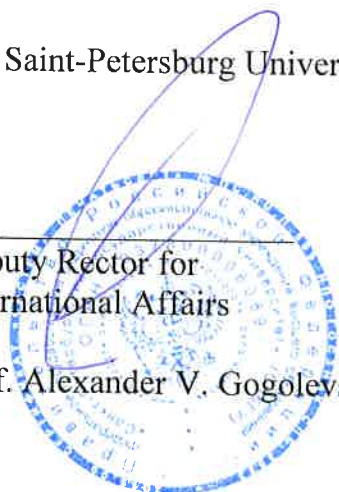
In order to implement the Program of Academic and Student Exchange, Saint-Petersburg State University and Tallinn University have agreed to state clause 7 of the Program in the following wording:

7. The host institution will offer assistance to an exchange program participant in finding an acceptable place of residence on campus or off campus for the period of study or work in the host institution. However, neither SPbU nor Tallinn University are required to provide material support for room, board, travel, insurance, visas, and other personal expenses (including purchase of books). The parties acknowledge that payment of those expenses will be made by exchange program participants.

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education Saint-Petersburg State University (hereinafter referred to as «Saint-Petersburg University»), duly represented by Andryushin S.V., Deputy Rector for International Affairs, acting on the basis of proxy dated 25.07.2016 № 28-21-258, from one side,

and

Tallinn University, represented by Prof. Tiit Land, Rector, from the other side,


acting on the basis of the bilateral Cooperation Agreement between two respected universities, duly signed on October 17, 2011,

herewith agreed to prolong the Cooperation Agreement and the Program on Student and Faculty Exchange, between two respected universities, duly signed on October 17, 2011, for the next 5 (five)-year period and hence to consider it as valid till 2021.

In order to implement the Program of Academic and Student Exchange, Saint-Petersburg State University and Tallinn University have agreed to state clause 7 of the Program in the following wording:

7.
