



AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE

between

**SAINT-PETERSBURG UNIVERSITY,
RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

and

**SCHOOL OF BUSINESS
PONTIFICIA UNIVERSIDAD CATOLICA DE CHILE**

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Saint-Petersburg State University» (hereinafter abbreviated as SPbU), duly represented by Deputy Rector for International Affairs Prof. Alexander Gogolevsky acting on the basis of Proxy № 28-21-9 dated on 11.01.2016 valid till 31.12.2016, on the one part, and the School of Business from the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, (hereinafter abbreviated as PUC) duly represented by the President from the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, Mr. Ignacio Sánchez, on the other part, hereinafter collectively referred to as the Parties, have agreed to establish their academic cooperation and have concluded this Agreement on Student Exchange (hereinafter – the Agreement).

§ 1

1.1. The Parties will conduct the exchange of students for non-degree studies in the field of Management in accordance with the rules and regulations set in this Agreement.

§ 2

The Parties agree to set following terms and conditions for student exchange:

2.1. The total number of exchange students from each Party shall not exceed 4 (four) students for exchange study per academic year, or 2 (two) students for exchange study during each term. In exceptional cases and after negotiation between both parties, the number of exchange students can be increased per academic year and/or the exchange period can be prolonged for more than it is stipulated in this Agreement. The Parties strive to distribute the candidates for exchanges evenly throughout the academic year and keep the balance of exchange student number from each university annually.

2.1.1. SPbU will send up to 2 (two) Undergraduate (BSc) students and/or up to 2 (two) Master (MSc) students to PUC, for exchange study in the Undergraduate (BSc) or MBA programs correspondingly.
