

**Memorandum of Understanding on
Educational and Research Cooperation
on the
Biomedical Research joint Project
Between
St. Petersburg University, Russian Federation
and
Harbin Medical University, China**

Harbin Medical University, duly represented by its President Yang Baofeng,
and

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Saint-Petersburg State University» (hereinafter - SPbU), duly represented by its Dean of the Faculty of Medicine Piotr Yablonsky,

in a mutual desire to promote further intercultural, educational and technological exchange, to continue and develop educational and research cooperation between SPbU and Heilongjiang province in accordance with the memorandum on educational and scientific cooperation between the People's Government of Heilongjiang Province and Saint-Petersburg State University, signed on May 23, 2014,

by this Memorandum of Understanding express their intention to work together to promote academic cooperation under the following terms:

1. COOPERATION AREAS

- (1) Joint research activities.
- (2) Short-term visits of faculty members for lectures, conferences, colloquia, and symposia or other academic activities.
- (3) Exchange of information and pertinent publication in fields of interest to both institutions.
- (4) Exchange of faculty members and students for study and research.
- (5) Cooperation on the joint project in Biomedical Research in order to conduct mutual educational and research projects in the fields of pharmacology, cardiology, endemic pathology, oncology, infectious diseases, and other areas of common scientific interest.

2. COOPERATION EXERCISE

Each cooperative exercise will be established and managed through a separate future agreement. The fields of study will be designated for each case, based on mutual interests. The conditions for employing the achieved results as well as the arrangements for specific visits and exchanges will be endorsed by both parties in each specific case.

3. FUND

Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will depend upon availability of funds in each specific case, which may be joint and/or separately sought by both institutions.

4. TERM OF CONTRACT

This MOU will become effective from the date of signing by the representatives of both institutions and will remain valid for an initial period of five years. This MOU will be subjected to review after this period and may be extended or renewed in mutual accordance. At any time, the terms of this MOU may be amended by mutual agreement in writing.

5. TERMINATION

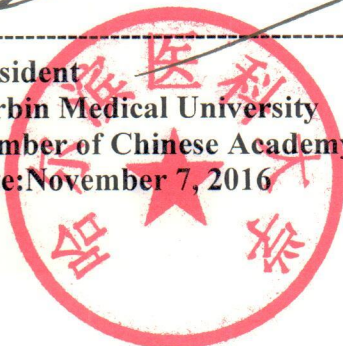
This MOU may be terminated by either institution with a six-month notice. No applications shall be considered after this notice; however, the institutions will continue to fulfil their obligations to accepted exchange students until the completion of their study plans.
