

Agreement for Academic Exchange and Cooperation between Saint-Petersburg State University and Nagoya University of Foreign Studies

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Saint-Petersburg State University" (hereinafter referred to as SPbU), duly represented by its Deputy Rector for International Affairs Sergey Andryushin, acting on the basis of proxy dated 30.12.2016 № 28-21-486, and Nagoya University of Foreign Studies desiring to develop academic exchange and cooperation in education and research between the two institutions, have agreed as follows:

1. The two institutions, based on the principles of respect for each other's independence and of mutual benefit, will do the following activities:
 - (1) Exchange of students and academic staff
 - (2) Joint research activities
 - (3) Exchange of academic materials
2. In order to carry out the above-mentioned activities, a detailed plan may be formed after consultation between the two institutions.
3. It is implicit that each and every activity undertaken in the name of this agreement will be approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and must fit within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints.
4. This agreement shall be effective on and after the date of its signing by the presidents of the two institutions and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years, unless either party wishes to terminate it, with one year's written notice. The agreement may be renewed by mutual written consent.
5. This agreement may be modified at any time after due consultation between the two institutions.
