



## AMENDING AGREEMENT

**THIS AMENDING AGREEMENT** made as of July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018 is between

**Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Saint-Petersburg State University»** (hereinafter referred to as “Saint-Petersburg University”), duly represented by its Vice-Rector for International Affairs Sergey Andryushin, acting on the basis of proxy dated 07.12.2017 № 28-21-410, on the one part,

and

**SKEMA Business School**, a private establishment of higher education and research with the legal status of a non-profit association under the French “1901 law” and having registered office at Avenue Willy Brandt, 59777 Euralille, represented by Dr. Alice Guilhon, Dean and Dr. Patrice Houdayer, Vice-Dean, Programs, International, and Student Life

### WHEREAS:

- A. the parties entered into an International Academic Student Exchange Agreement effective as of April 12, 2012 for the establishment of a mutually beneficial institutional academic exchange program, a copy of which is attached as Schedule “A” (the “**Agreement of Student Exchange**”);
- B. the term of the Student Exchange Agreement was for five (5) years with automatic renewal every five years;
- C. the parties confirm the positive results stemming from the student exchange activities undertaken under the Student Exchange Agreement; and
- D. the parties wish to extend the term of the Student Exchange Agreement to cover both Master Level students (Programme Grande Ecole) as well as Undergraduate level students (Bachelor in Business Administration) on the same terms, conditions and covenants contained in the Student Exchange Agreement;

**NOW THEREFORE** in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows

1. The front page is amended as follow :

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3. The article 2.6 is amended as follow :

“All the exchange students should have a medical insurance valid on the territory of the host country during the whole exchange period. All the incoming exchange students at SKEMA who are non-EU citizens must purchase health insurance before applying for their student visa and, they will be required to enrol in the “French Sécurité Sociale”. All students must have repatriation coverage during their stay at the host country.”

4. Except as otherwise defined herein, any terms used in this Amending Agreement have the meanings prescribed by the Student Exchange Agreement.
5. All other terms of the Student Exchange Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
