## RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN SAINT PETERSBURG STATE UNIVERSITY, RUSSIA  
AND  
NAGOYA UNIVERSITY OF COMMERCE & BUSINESS, JAPAN

Saint Petersburg State University (SPbU) and Nagoya University of Commerce & Business (NUCB), wishing to continue with the academic cooperation between the two institutions with a goal of developing academic and cultural exchange in education, research, and other areas, agree to extend the agreement signed by both parties through their representatives, Vice-Rector for International Affairs Sergey Andryushin, and the Chancellor of NUCB, Prof. Hiroyuki Kurimoto.

This agreement continues to have the same provisions of the previous agreement/memorandum.

### Effective Date and Length of Agreement

This agreement shall come into force after it has been signed and will be binding upon all parties for a period of five (5) years, from the 2020/2021 academic year through to the 2025/2026 academic year. The Agreement shall be automatically renewed for additional one-year periods unless either Party notifies the other Party no later than six months prior to the expiration of the preceding term that it wishes to terminate this Agreement.
